

2. FIRE FIGHTING TRAINING

COURSE OBJECTIVE

This program is for every employee, supervisor or person who may be exposed to fire and the inherent risks associated with fire. All of us have at one time or another been exposed to fire or injury and property loss as a result of a fire, after just such an incident most people will find themselves asking questions that start with "What if?". The basic fire-fighting course prepares people to react correctly and deal with incipient stage fire reducing or preventing property loss or injury.

AIM

The aim of this course is to make every participant conversant with the basic principles of the theory of combustion. Know how to operate and control different types of fires and understand the basic principals of fire prevention and fire detection techniques. Each participant will know how to Extinguish incipient Class A, Class B, and Class C fires so that the correct extinguisher is chosen, the fire is completely extinguished, and proper extinguisher-handling techniques are followed.
